



## **Title VI Non-Discrimination Policy**


It is T.Y. Lin International's policy to comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended; its implementing regulations; and all other applicable laws prohibiting nondiscrimination in connection with federally-assisted programs of the United States Department of Transportation (DOT) ("federally assisted programs").

T.Y. Lin International does not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age, disability, or limited English proficiency.

T.Y. Lin International does not discriminate in the selection or retention of subconsultants in connection with federally assisted programs, including procurements of materials and leases of equipment.

In all solicitations, either by competitive bidding or negotiation made by T.Y. Lin International for work to be performed under a federally assisted program, including procurements of materials or equipment, each potential subcontractor or supplier shall be notified of the contractor's obligations under the contract and the applicable regulations with regard to nondiscrimination on the ground of race, color, national origin, sex, age, disability, or limited English proficiency. Lin International will include the necessary nondiscrimination provisions in every covered subcontract; including procurements of materials and leases of equipment, unless exempt by the Regulations, or directives issued pursuant thereto.
